General Information

Parking: Buses may drop teams off in parking lot near track, but they must park off site or find a spot in the high school gym parking lot located on 18th st. (see map) Fans may park in the parking lots at track. In the event of inclement weather, team buses may use staff lot to shelter teams

Spectators: \$10- Adults, \$5- Students. Spectators must remain in the bleachers. Spectators are not allowed inside the fenced area of the track. Spectators may watch the field events from the bleachers or from outside the fenced area of the track

Team camps: Teams may camp in the tennis courts or in the grassy area near tennis courts and football stadium. See map for locations of team camps. Only competing athletes or athletes warming up are allowed inside the fenced area of the track. All other athletes must be in team camps. Athletes are not allowed in the bleachers.

Warmup area: The warm up area will be located on the north end of the football field. Only competing athletes or athletes warming up are allowed inside the fenced area of the track. All other athletes must be in team camps.

Awards: Team trophy to be awarded to the first and second place teams
Individual medals to be awarded to 1-6 place finishers
Athletes will claim medal from awards tent when results are announced

Locker Rooms: No locker Rooms will be available at Cloquet High School. There are bathrooms located near the concession stand along with port a potties located throughout the facility.

Running Surface: 8 lane, 400 meter all - weather track. ½" pyramid spikes or less may be worn on track and jump/vault runways. Absolutely no pin spikes will be permitted. Clerk of course will check spikes during meet.

Starting Blocks: Blocks will be provided. We use Gill blocks. Schools using stand-up (Moye) blocks are asked to provide their own. Blocks must be approved by the starter prior to the meet

Results: Complete results will be provided to each head coach in a timely fashion at the conclusion of each day of competition. Results will also be posted on the MSHSL website and the isd94.org website, activities tab

Trainer: A certified athletic trainer will be on site

Severe Weather: Decisions regarding the mandatory suspension of the meet due to severe weather (in case of lightning, etc.) will be made by on site medical staff and safety personnel. Decisions regarding potential suspension of the meet due to non-mandatory conditions (severe rain, etc.) will be made by the Referee(s) and the Meet Manager. In the event of inclement weather, team buses may use the staff lot to shelter teams.

Coaches Meeting: A meeting for all boys head coaches and girls head coaches will be held at 9:15 in or near the high school cafeteria

Clerking Area: Athletes are to report to the Clerk of Course to check in and receive hip numbers at the north end of the track.

Relay Cards: Relay cards with relay personnel shall be submitted to the Meet Manager or the press box.

Markings: All markings for the long jump, triple jump, high jump, and pole vault must be on the side of the runway. Athletes are asked to remove their tape at the completion of their event. Our track has the updated exchange zones for the 400 and 800 meter relays.

Implement Inspection: Implement inspection will take place from 8:30 a.m. – 9:30 a.m. each day in the Clerk of Course tent at the north end of the track. The assigned officials will mark those that are legal and impound those which do not meet the proper specifications.

Disqualification: Upon disqualification, the Referee will inform the coach or participant involved. Protests should be made in writing in accordance with the NFHS rule book no later than 30 minutes after the results have been announced or made official. All protests should be turned into the press box.

Jury of Appeals: A Jury of Appeals will settle all disputes which arise during the meet. If a committee member's school is directly involved in the dispute that school will not participate in the final decision process resolving the dispute. The Jury of Appeals will consist of the Meet Manager, Head Starter, and the head coaches from the schools listed below:

Hermantown, Hibbing, and North Branch Alternates: Princeton and St. Francis

Electronic Devices: At all Section Meets and at the State meet, i-pads, cellphones, and all other electronic devices will not be allowed in competitive or restricted areas. We will clarify the areas at the Wednesday coaches meeting. Certain meet officials shall be allowed to use their cell phones for meet communication only
