Daily Structure	Students will be in school for regularly scheduled times and will follow their normal class schedule. Physical distancing will be encouraged by all students and staff, however space will limit what we can do. Movement throughout the building and in the classroom will be limited and controlled.	Students will be placed in a 3 day (Group A/Group B/Group C) rotation with 1/3 of the students attending school on one day while the other 2/3 will participate in a distance learning environment. The A/B/C rotation will be based on households - all children within a family will be placed on the same schedule. With health and safety protocols in place, including mandatory social distancing, increased hygiene practices, and the use of personal protective equipment, all students will physically attend school 1 of every 3 days. The other 2 days will be distance learning days. Some students, which will be identified by staff, may be offered an opportunity to be on site daily to meet increased educational needs.	Learning from home. Students will receive the same content and pacing as in-person learning.
