Yesterday a message was shared regarding the beginning of the school year. In alignment with the Minnesota Safe Learning Plan, our most likely models for the opening of the school year, based on current data, are in-person learning for all grade levels or in-person learning for elementary students and hybrid learning for secondary students. We will continue to monitor data through August 21st and announce the opening model early during the week of August 24th. The Minnesota Safe Learning Plan requires schools to provide distance learning to families who choose not to send their student(s) to in-person or hybrid learning. This option will be available the entire year to any family who wishes to use it. A sign-up process for distance learning will be shared when the final decision for the start of the school year is announced. Please know distance learning will always be an option to interested families for the 2020-21 school year.
